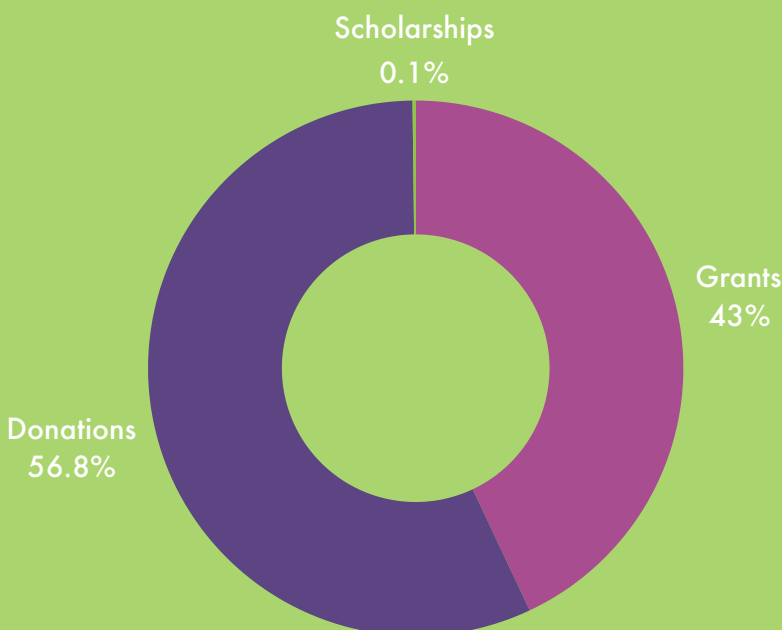

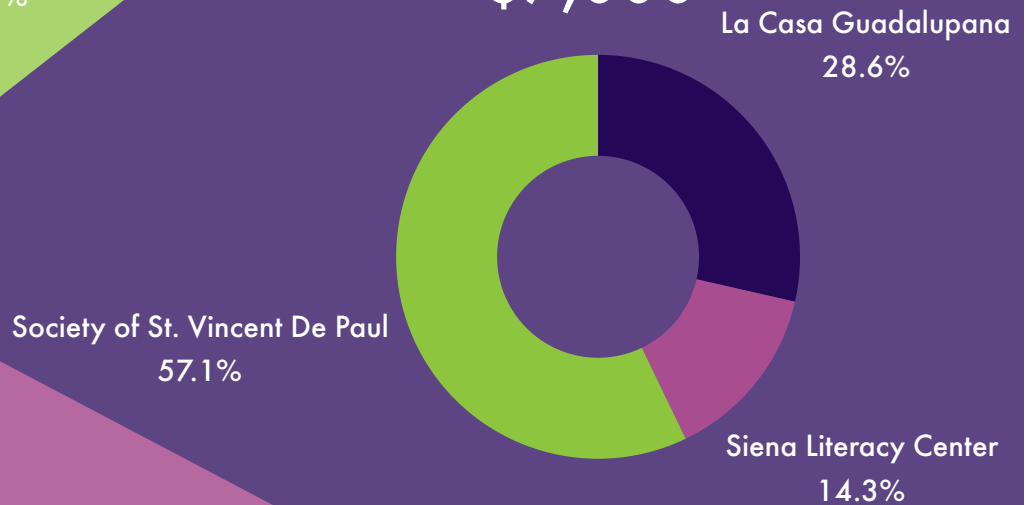

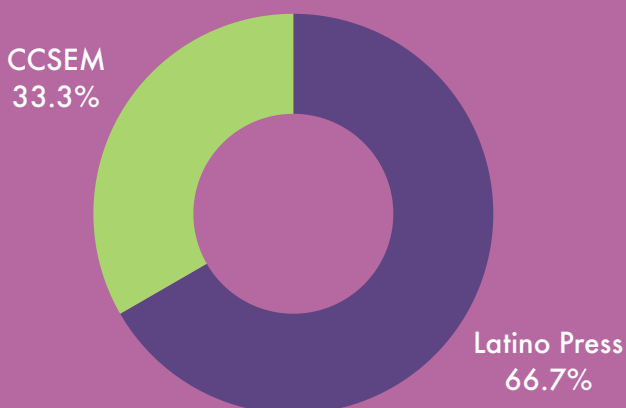

Each fall, Alliance Catholic Foundation, in conjunction with the Catholic High School League, awards \$20,000 in scholarships to 10 students who will be attending a Catholic High School League school in the upcoming academic year.

The 7th Annual Live It. Show It. Share It. Scholarship assignment was to create an idea for a podcast designed for high school students about the Catholic faith. Applicants had to name the podcast, write a synopsis of it including why they think it would be successful, and record an intro for it.

La Casa Guadalupeana works to revitalize the environment and improve conditions in the lives of the Hispanic community of Southwest Detroit by providing education, health information and support services for families, ultimately helping them improve their economic security and future prospects.

Adult Literacy

The \$2,000 grant from Alliance Catholic Foundation helped provide English classes to Hispanic men and women in the Detroit community. The goal of the project was to provide participants with the opportunity and support to advance their education, enabling them to establish themselves in the workplace and improve their employability, creating more opportunities for themselves and their families.

Siena Literacy Center

Siena Literacy Center provides effective education programs for adults seeking to improve their ability to successfully meet the challenges of everyday living by learning foundational skills in reading, writing, and math, and/or English as a Second Language in keeping with the Dominican commitment to education.

Recruitment of Volunteer Tutors

The \$1,000 grant from Alliance Catholic Foundation helped recruit and retain 93 volunteer tutors, who are paired with adult basic education and English language learners at Siena Literacy Center. The grant was also used to improve instruction delivery by offering high-quality tutor trainings in topics such as Reading Issues; Trauma-Informed Tutoring; Science of Reading; Lesson Planning; and Information Processing.
